Part time Interventions teacher 1 term full time, 2 terms part time	To support Pupil Premium pupils in Year 5 and 6. Learning is 'assessment-led planned' to support and extend the progress through smaller classes led by an experienced teacher.	£32000
Part time SEND/ Interventions Manager Calculated as 50% of the overall cost.	There's a strong link between our PP children and those having SEND/ Interventions support. Having the manager non-classed based allows the children, and parents, to receive tailored, targeted support, particularly in Yr 3 and 4.	£25000
Siblings Support Programme	Over half of our Pupil Premium children have a sibling in the school; this is above the school's average. Dare2Dream group devised and delivered a 7 week programme that looked at how the siblings could work together in school and at home, supporting each other emotionally and trying to give an extra boost to their learning.	£1300
Other provision funded by Pupil Premium include; buying in of professional services – SEND, EAL and Behaviour Support, Educational Psychologist, attendance officer; Forest School; Nurture provision; Children's Learning Mentor, Financial support for trips.
